

Music 231 Collaborative Assignment Guidelines

Because collaborative efforts enhance the learning process from some, students have the option of working on certain assignments in pairs (i.e. two students). Students can choose to do this for any or all of the assignments listed below, with the noted specific conditions. Students can work with the same partners, or not, each time.

Students choosing this option must complete the assignment as specified and simply put both names on the paper. Each student in the pair will receive the same grade. Both students will also receive the same redo grade if an assignment is redone.

The following assignments may be done collaboratively (in pairs), with the listed conditions:

- First Species: two (instead of one) exercises – one in a minor key, one in a major key; one upper, and one lower counterpoint
- Second Species: two (instead of one) exercises – one in a minor key, one in a major key; one upper, and one lower counterpoint
- Third Species: two (instead of one) exercises – two (instead of one) exercises – one in a minor key, one in a major key; one upper, and one lower counterpoint
- Fourth Species: two (instead of one) exercises – two (instead of one) exercises – one in a minor key, one in a major key; one upper, and one lower counterpoint
- Fifth Species: two (instead of one) exercises – two (instead of one) exercises – one in a minor key, one in a major key; one upper, and one lower counterpoint
